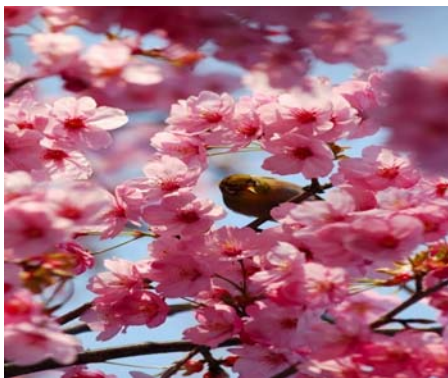

Cervical Cancer

Cervical cancer is the second-most common cause of death from cancer in women across the world. About 11,070 women will find out they have invasive cervical cancer this year and about 3,870 women will die from cervical cancer. Over the last 50 years, routine Pap test screening for cervical cancer has reduced deaths from the cancer by 74%.

Program objectives include:

Discuss screening, diagnostics, precursors to cervical cancer.

Review current causes, treatment and spread of cervical cancer.

Discuss HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) infection, HPV protection and current guidelines for vaccination.
