The purpose of this 2-day course is to prepare nurses and other health care providers to provide quality care for patients with advanced illness at the end-of-life.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course participants will be able to describe the role of the nurse in:

- Providing palliative nursing care
- Utilizing the principles of pain and symptom management for patients with advanced disease.
- Addressing ethical issues that occur at the end-of-life.
- Providing culturally sensitive care at the end-of-life.
- Communication techniques that improve end-of-life care.
- Key concepts for facilitating health adaptation to loss for patients, family and healthcare workers.
- Providing care at the time of death.
