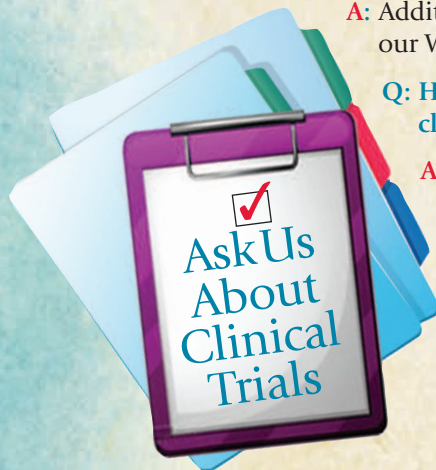
Q: Where can I park?

A: Valet parking is available to Cancer Institute of New Jersey patients at a discounted rate of \$3.00 for up to two hour or less or a flat rate of \$6.00 for anytime over two hours. Be sure to have your parking receipt stamped at the front desk to receive this discounted price for parking.

If you do not wish to use the valet service, a list of parking alternatives is included for your consideration. See the document called "Parking Options for Patients".
