Part One:

Qualifying Test – 90-minute multiple choice test. **March 4, 2017** at 12:00 pm or 4:00 pm). Students with qualifying scores will receive invitations to the onsite team tournament.

Part Two:

Team Tournament – Qualifying teams of 4-5 will be invited to compete onsite at Rutgers University – New Brunswick on Saturday, May 20, 2017.
