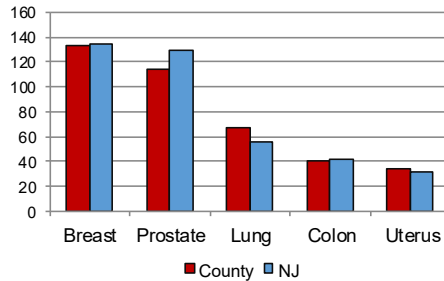

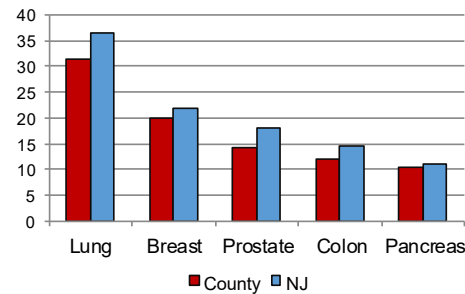

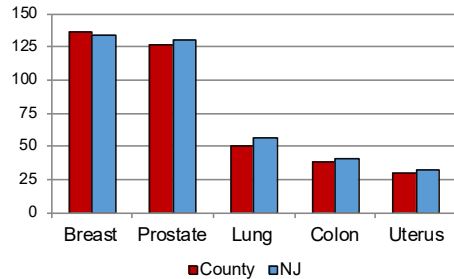

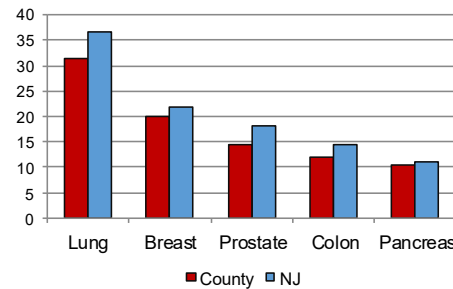

- PSA rates were the lowest among low-income (31.7%) and Hispanic/Latino respondents (33.5%)
- Colorectal screening rates were lowest among Black/African American (55.0%) and low-income respondents (56.7%).

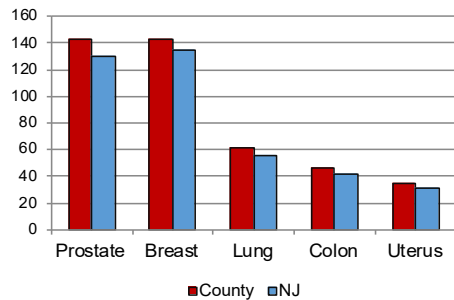

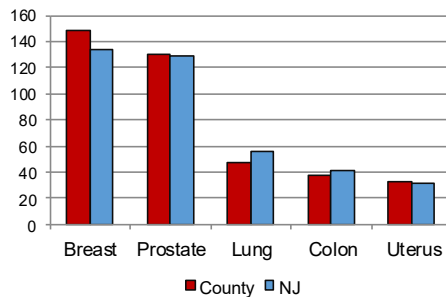

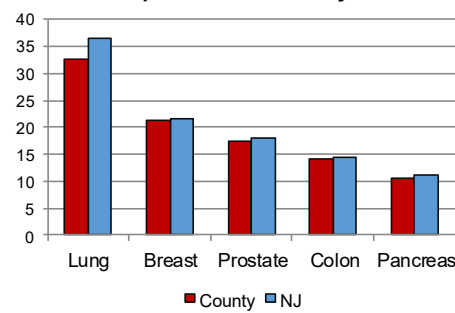
