



Quick Reference for Symptoms:

When to Call Your Healthcare Team

Symptom	Dial 911 or go to ER	Dial the Nursing Help Line: 732-235-2465
Alertness	 Unable to arouse or wake up Seizure Loss of movement in any part of your body 	 New or increased confusion Change in vision Falling down New numbness or tingling Dizziness Major mood changes Sleeplessness Lethargic (extreme fatigue) Tremors/shakiness
Bleeding	 Uncontrolled bleeding Vomiting of blood 	 New or increased bleeding Bloody urine Coughing up blood Nosebleeds Dark or bloody stool One or more feminine pad per hour is used New easy bruising Little red or purple spots on the skin Bleeding from gums
Breathing	 Difficulty Breathing Choking 	 Trouble breathing when lying flat Wheezing with breaths New or persistent continuous cough Increased shortness of breath Sharp pain when breathing in
Constipation		 Constipation accompanied by a hard, tender, bloated abdomen Difficulty or painful passage of stools that are hard or dry No bowel movement for 3 or more days or change from baseline

Symptom	Dial 911 or go to ER	Dial the Nursing Help Line: 732-235-2465
Diarrhea		 Constant or uncontrolled diarrhea (> 3 times/day) Diarrhea for more than 12 hours while on medication to stop it Diarrhea with fever or abdominal cramping Signs of dehydration (excessive thirst, palpitations, dizziness, dark-looking urine or less urine) Stool which is bloody or dark
Fatigue	 Unable to wake up Lethargic (extreme fatigue), difficult to keep awake 	 Dizziness Too tired to get out of bed or walk to the bathroom Shortness of breath Fatigue is getting worse
Infection	 Lethargic (extreme fatigue), difficult to arouse Hematology and transplant patients on chemotherapy with a temperature 100.0 °F or above 	 Temperature 100.4 °F or above ***For Hematology or Transplant Patients 100.0 °F Shaking chills even if temperature is normal Frequent urination with or without burning or discomfort New cough, sore throat, mouth/lip sores Mucus that has changed in color to green or yellow Earaches, headaches, stiff neck Toothache Cuts that won't heal or become red/swollen Unusual vaginal discharge or itching Sinus pain or pressure
IV Site Problems		 New redness or swelling around area of IV or port site Pain around port-a-cath, Hickman[®], or PICC site or surrounding area
Mouth sores or sores in throat (mucositis or stomatitis)	 Cannot swallow 	 White patches, sores or painful areas in or around the mouth Difficulty swallowing food or fluid Bright red blood in mouth
Nausea/ vomiting	 Vomit blood or vomit that looks like "coffee grounds" Projectile vomiting (vomit shoots out for a distance) 	 Uncontrolled nausea or vomiting with or without medicine Severe stomach pain while vomiting Unable to take medicines due to nausea/vomiting

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Pain	 Severe chest pain (squeezing or pressure in chest) Headache felt as being "the worst ever" Back pain with sudden weakness in legs, arms or unable to move legs 	 New or uncontrolled pain with or without use of pain medicines Headaches not relieved with over-the-counter pain medicines Burning in chest or stomach New abdominal or back pains Sinus pain/eye pain or pressure Numbness/tingling in hands or feet
Rash		 New or changes in skin rash Rash with severe pain, blisters or itching Redness and/or tenderness on palms or soles of feet
Swelling		 Sudden swelling in any part of the body with or without pain Increased swelling
Urination		 Trying but unable to urinate for more than 4 hours Change in color or blood in urine Painful urination Strong odor of urine Weak stream or dribbling while urinating
