- Engage in basic, clinical, or population-based cancer research for eight weeks during two consecutive summers. (2025 and 2026)
- Receive curriculum development support to design innovative curricula to take back to the classrooms.
- Present their research findings at an Annual Research Symposium.
- Receive compensation for their time and limited funds towards childcare and parking.
