WHO WE ARE?

The *Rutgers Youth Enjoy Science (RUYES)* program seeks to encourage students interested in the biomedical sciences to pursue cancer research and healthcare careers. RUYES Educators engage in cancer-focused research, curriculum/course building, and outreach to enhance the value of STEM education and science research careers among their students. The RUYES program is funded by the National Institutes of Health/National Cancer Institute grant 2R25CA247785.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

Educators will have the opportunity to:

- Engage in basic, clinical, or population-based cancer research for eight weeks during two consecutive summers. (2026 and 2027)
- Receive curriculum development support to design innovative curricula to imbed within their courses.
- Present their research findings at an Annual Research Symposium.
- Receive compensation for time and limited funds are available to support childcare, and transportation/parking.
